


Pilgrimage with Debbie



Dear Ladies, This summer as I have been preparing for the new year of ministry exploring our pilgrimage on this earth, I have been reminded that Jesus, when He spent time on this earth (with the goal of doing the Father's will and giving His life for us), lived a life of compassion for people in pain, emotionally, psychologically, spiritually and physically. He both felt compassion and acted with compassion. In His story of the good Samaritan, Jesus describes two types of people: 1) Those who see the beaten traveler but do not get involved, hurrying to do "ministry" elsewhere, and 2) Those who see the beaten traveler, feel true heartfelt compassion, cross the road, get involved, and in fact get dirty. In our religiosity, we can become immune to the pain of others, busy with our "good deeds" and "religious acts" - not willing to get dirty, to really see the pain of those around us. It just might be uncomfortable or inconvenient or painful to get involved—to truly act in compassion. But, should we forget as we travel this road to Zion, that Jesus was the model of pilgrimage? He listened. He saw into the heart. His heart broke for the broken-hearted people in the world. Jesus did not worry about what people thought of Him. He was concerned about doing the Father's will during His brief sojourn on earth. He knew that His citizenship is in Heaven. And so it is with us — our citizenship is in Heaven. We are just passing through on the way to our final destination—Heaven. This is not our home. Hebrews 11:13 says that we are strangers and pilgrims" on this earth. Beth Moore emphasized in the Women of Faith pre-conference that we are just here "running an errand". This is not our permanent abode. So, as we travel, our heart should be focused on God and eternity, and then we will develop the heart of God and have hearts of compassion that are reflected in our actions here during our journey on earth. 
But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control.


Living What You Believe


